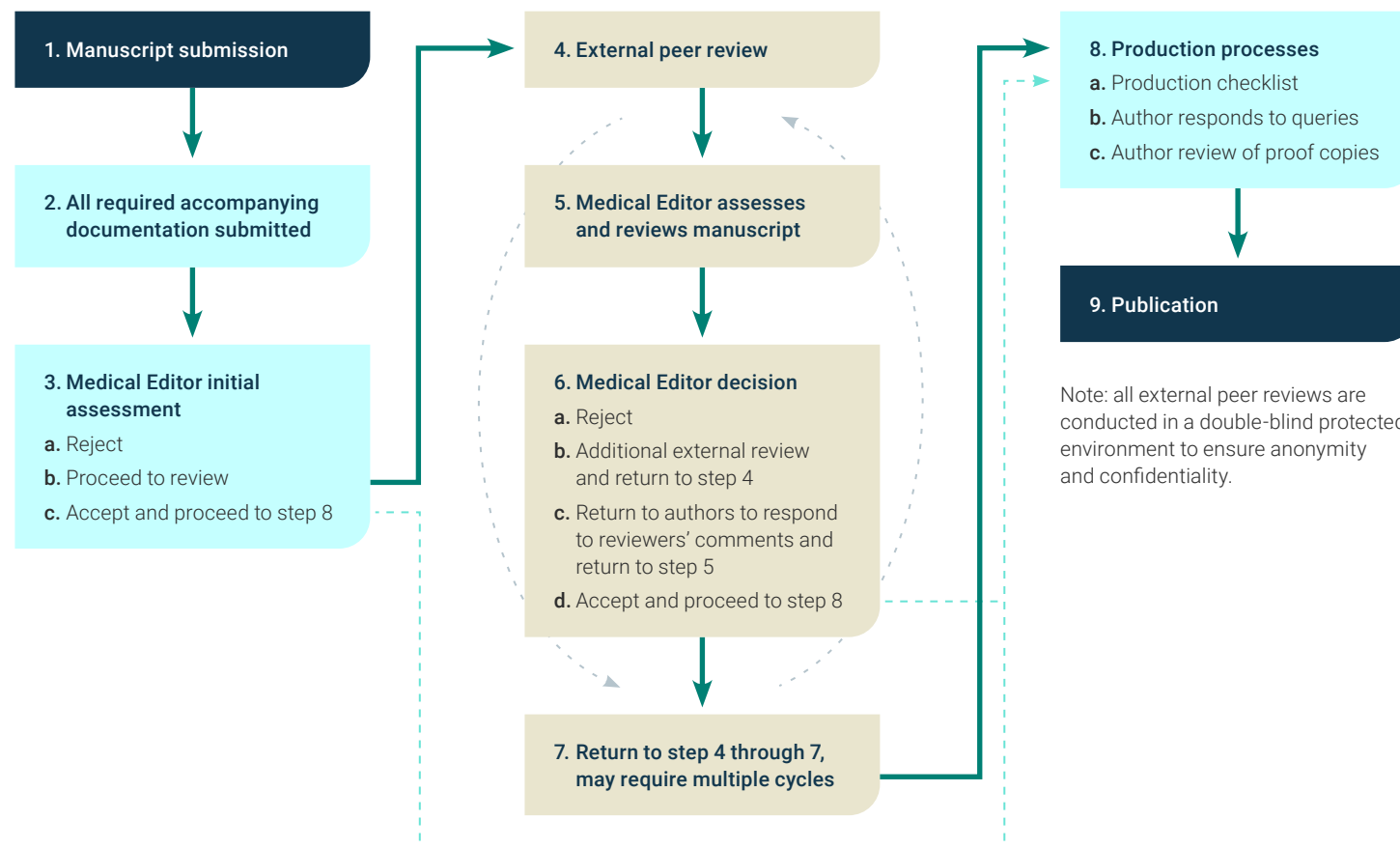


AJGP publication process (including peer review)

Steps required for publication

Each step must be completed successfully to proceed to the next step.



Requirements for external reviewers

- All documents and correspondence remain confidential
- Advise Medical Editor if you:
 - have a potential conflict of interest
 - consider this paper to be outside your area of expertise
 - unable to respond within the allocated time frame
- Consider paper within the context of the AJGP mission statement
- Not required to consider copyediting (grammar, punctuation, language)
- Provide appropriate comments to help guide the author on how best to improve their paper
- Advise Medical Editor in confidential section of additional significant concerns that would impede progression to publication
- Advise outcome recommendation
 - Accept
 - Revision
 - Reject

The Medical Editor and not the reviewers determine the outcome decision.

Peer reviewers are encouraged to consider standard texts and resources to help inform the review process. Please contact the Medical Editor if you would like more information.
